We started out in January with a huge winter storm. The storm produced 11 inches of snow in a short period of time. We plowed for 30 hours straight and then off & on for two days cleaning up intersections. Our area was declared a Federal Disaster Area. We received reimbursement check from the FEMA for 75% of fuel, labor and truck expenses in the amount of \$5,096.49.

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We were busy this year getting streets ready for our annual oil & chip. The cost for this years MFT program this year was \$29,500. We replaced a few sidewalks and curbs this year also. There was a bad section of road on Southland Park Drive. We jack hammered it out and repoured it. This made the residents on the road happy.
